STATE REPRESENTATIVE GREG DAVIDS ENDORSED FOR RE-ELECTION

Republican Delegates from House District 28B met in Rushford recently and unanimously endorsed State Representative Greg Davids for re-election to the Minnesota House of Representatives.

House District 28B includes all of Fillmore and Houston counties.

"I'd like to thank the delegates for their participation and am truly humbled by their support," Davids said.

Davids is completing his eleventh term in the Minnesota House. He is the Republican lead of the powerful Minnesota House Taxes Committee, and also serves on the Capital Investment, Commerce and Consumer Protection Finance and Policy, and Ways and Means committees.
